 - (d) "The entire history of the concept of structure... must be thought as a series of substitutions for centre for centre." Discuss with close reference to Derrida's "Structure, Sign and Play".

 - (b) How do you relate the lines from *Paradise Lost*, Book V which Coleridge quotes at the beginning of Chapter XIII to his concept of imagination?
