- d) Analyse *Wuthering Heights* as a study in the conventions and exclusions of Victorian society.

- a) In *Great Expectations*, the language and metaphor of money dominates as a theme. Discuss.
- b) Discuss how in *Great Expectations*, "Dickens uses Pip's story to reveal complex truths about justice and injustice in Victorian England".
- c) Critically explore Conrad's representation of women characters in *Heart of Darkness*.
- d) Discuss Conrad's portrayal of the theme of violence and greed in *Heart of Darkness*.

 - a) Write a short note on Crusoe's experience of slavery.
 - b) Briefly discuss how Crusoe builds his house on an uninhabited island in *Robinson Crusoe*.

- c) "Oho! I declare he is that strange acquisition my late neighbour made in his journey to Liverpool a little Lascar, or an American or Spanish castaway". Who is the "he" referred to here? Analyse the speaker's representation of him.
- d) "It's twenty years," mourned the voice, "twenty years, I've been a wait for twenty years!" Whose voice do you think it is? What does the voice mourn?
- e) What dichotomy between Wemmick the apparently dull clerk and Wemmick the creative person does Pip notice when he enters Wemmick's "castle"?
- f) Discuss Pip's relationship with Joe in contrast to that of his sister.
- g) In Conrad's *Heart of Darkness*, what do the two women knitting at the Company office in Brussels symbolise?
- h) Critically comment on the significance of Kurtz's painting of the blindfolded woman in *Heart of Darkness*.
